There are tens of thousands of beaters and pickers up across the UK, and NOBs hope to provide them with a proactive and supportive voice. Founded by Mark Elliott, NOBs works by linking up gamekeepers or shoot captains with beaters, pickers up or loaders in the area.



NOBs believe there is no end to the potential of the organisation and aim to run Beating Courses and educational fairs for youngsters.

So if you're not registered yet, get on their website and become a member. Membership is only £5 per year, £10 for shoots/gamekeepers or you can purchase a lifetime membership for only £150.

Once registered with NOBs, your details will be held on a secure database until a gamekeeper or shoot captain requests people—NOBs then contact people in the area to find out who is available.

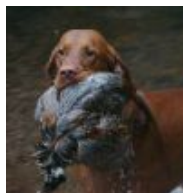
